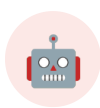

Users can trigger complex server actions with simple text prompts, a task that previously required custom code.



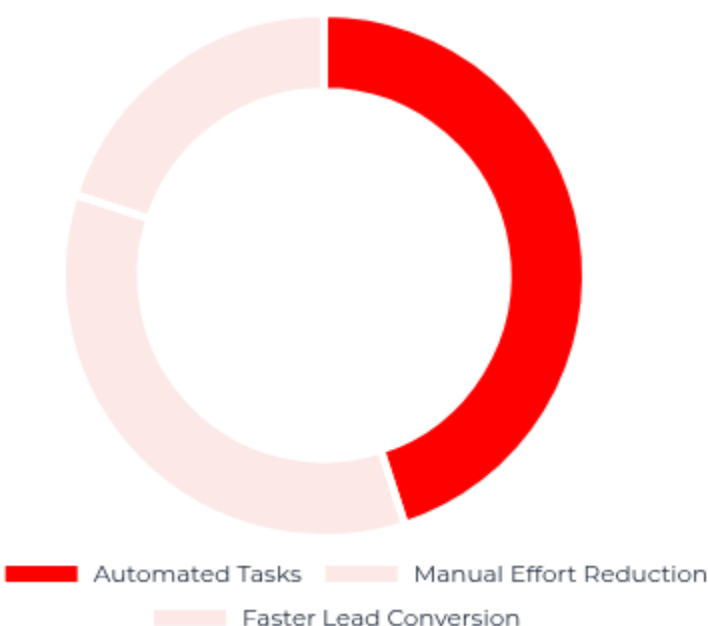
AI Sales & Accounting Agents

A foundational change simplifies inventory management by unifying Units of Measure (UoM) and packaging into a single model, reducing complexity and human error.



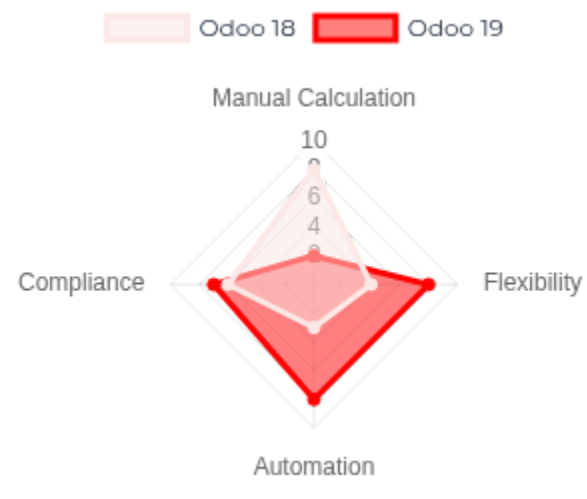
Manufacturing (MRP)

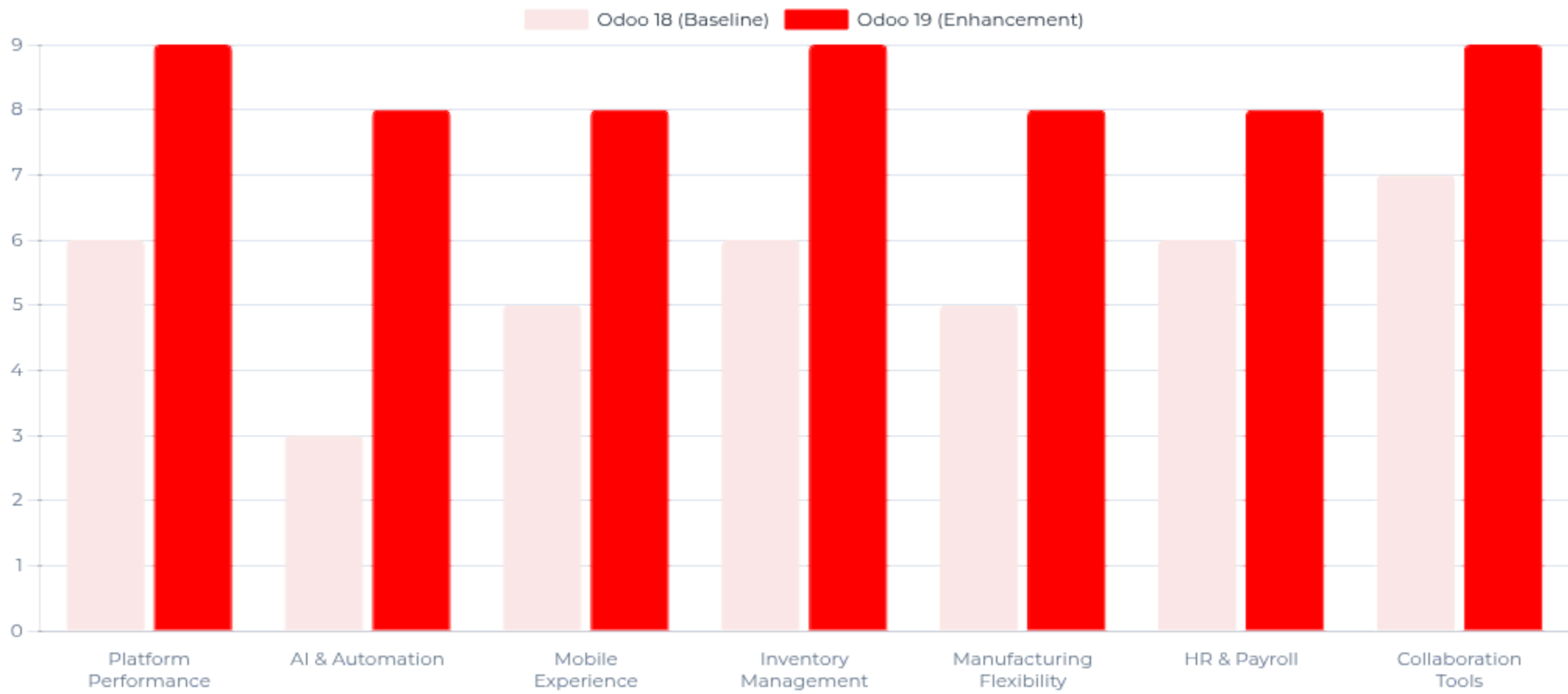
HR & Payroll
