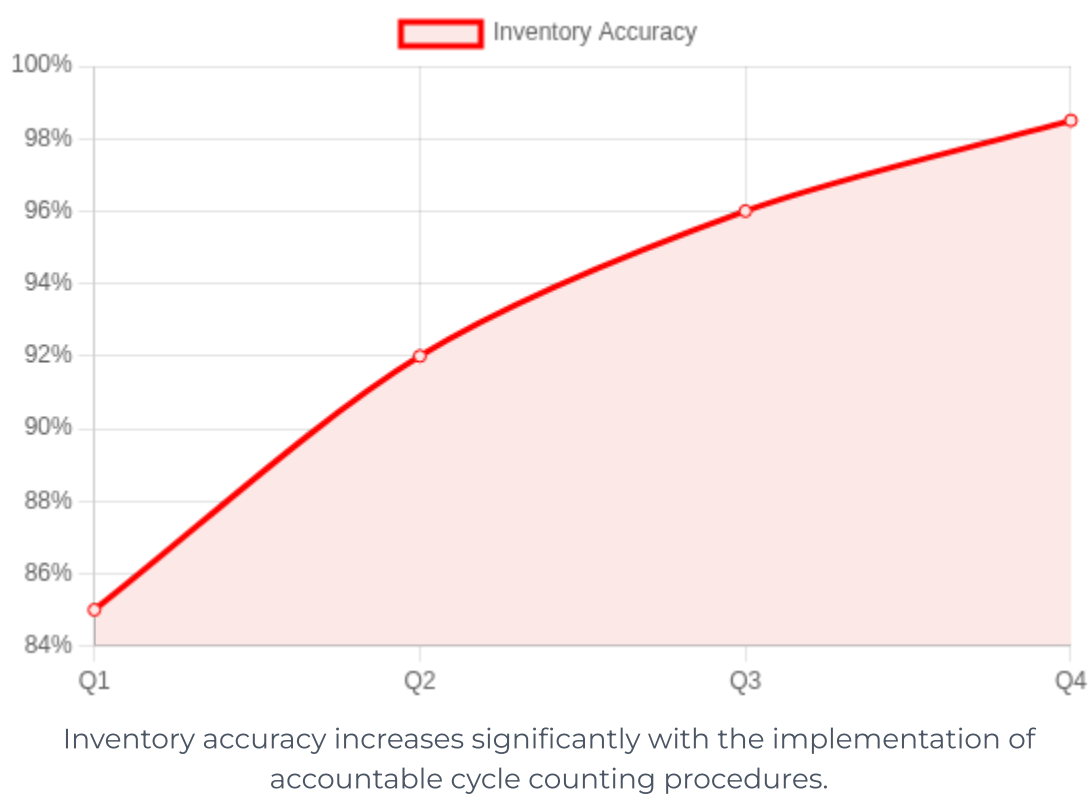

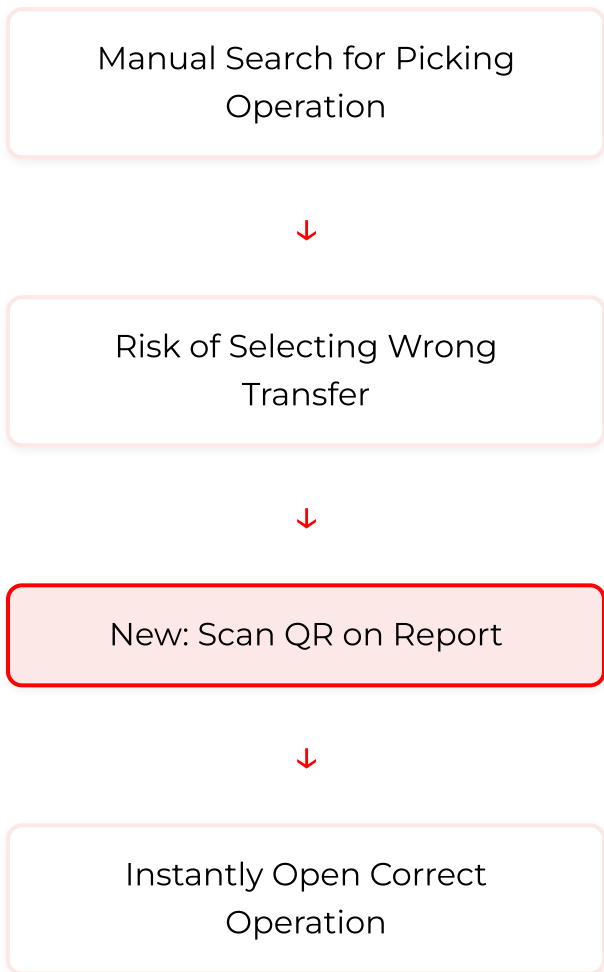
Warehouse Operations & Accuracy

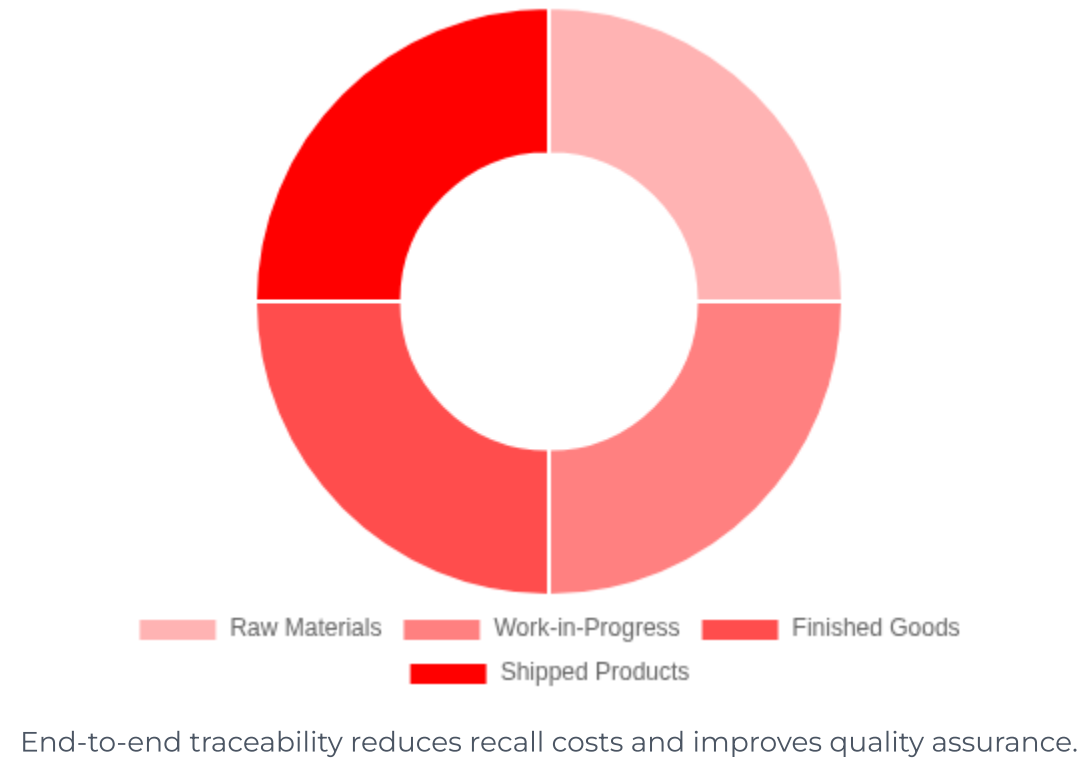
Streamlining Picking with QR Codes

Embedding QR codes on picking reports transforms a manual, error-prone task into a rapid, digital process, bridging the physical and digital warehouse seamlessly.



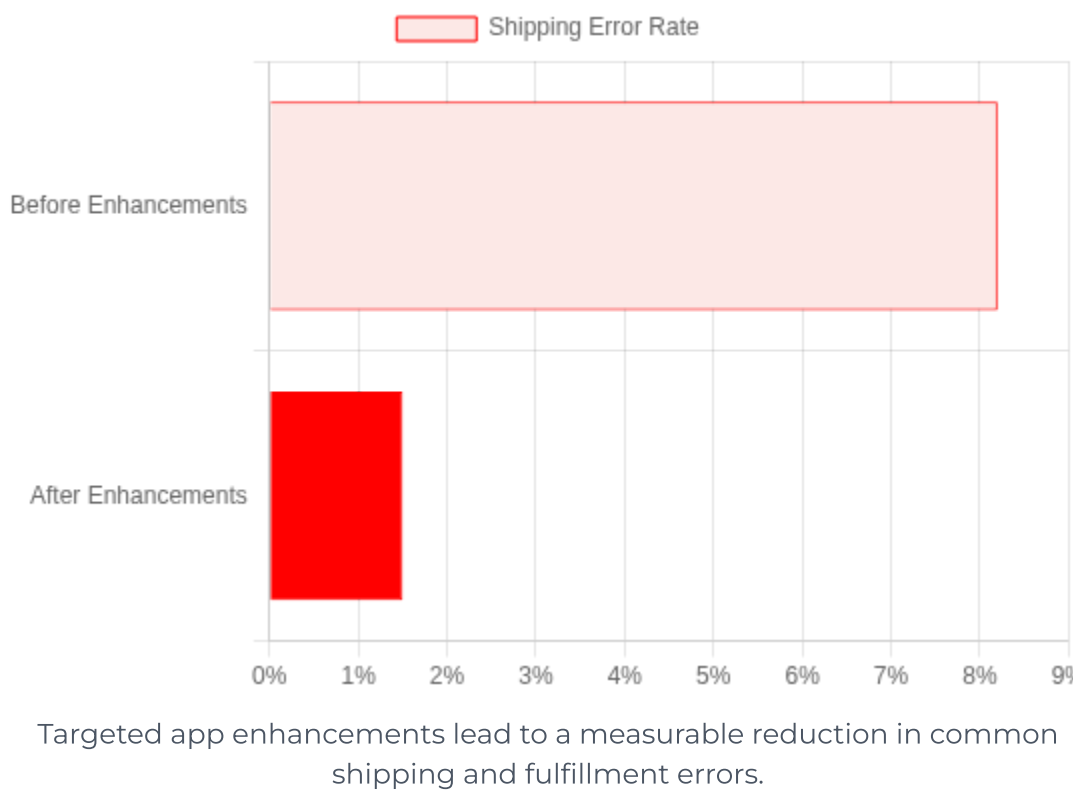
Product & Data Management

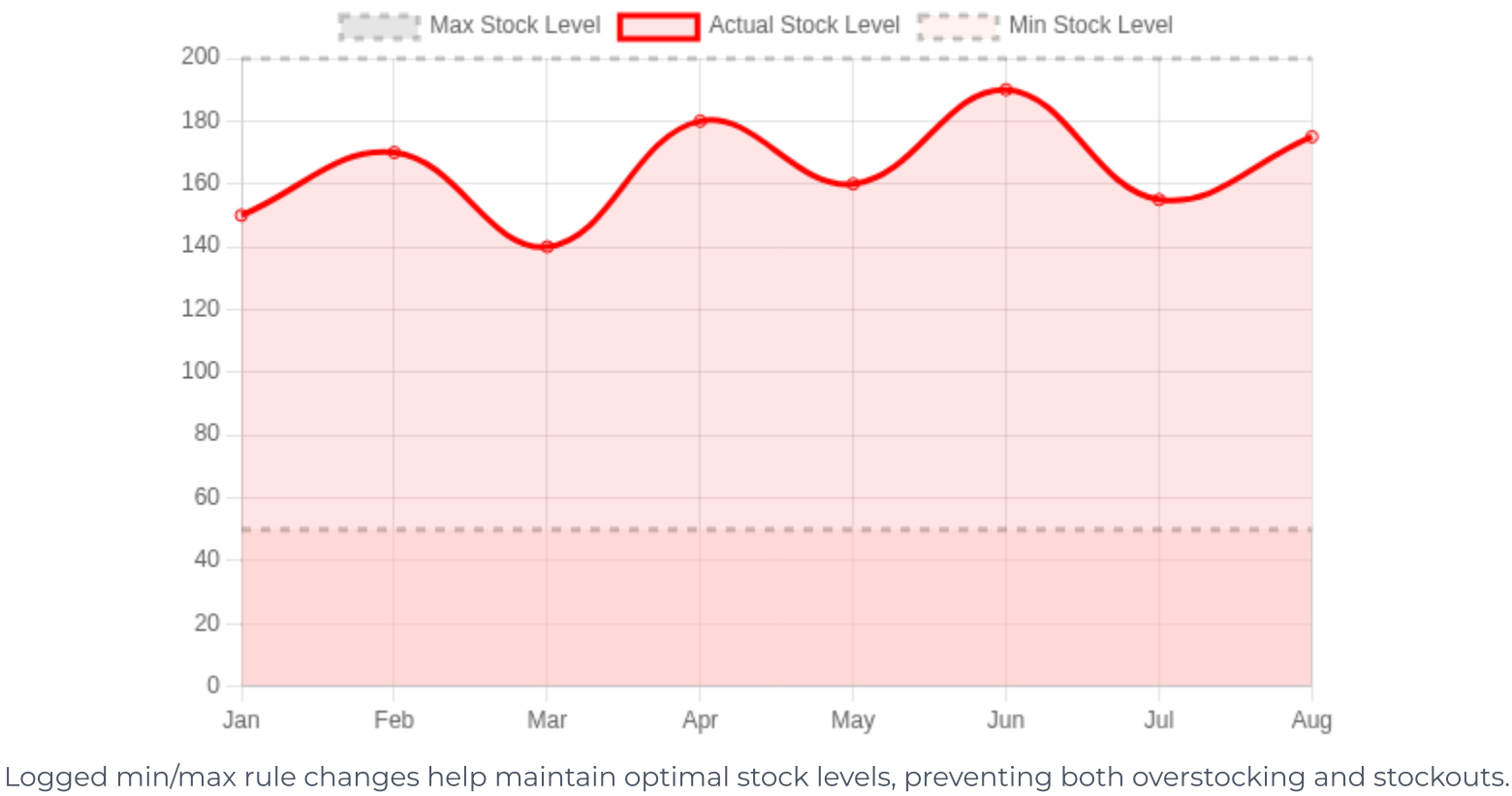
Order Fulfillment & Shipping
